Looking Ahead...

Signs of Suicide (SOS) and Human Trafficking Lessons: WCPSS requires counselors to deliver information to all 9th grade students about the warning signs and action steps for dealing with suicidal ideation and about the warning signs and dangers of human trafficking. These lessons are delivered through students' Healthful Living classes each semester. Additionally, students in 12th grade participate in a refresher lesson on the signs of suicide through their English classes.
