

Beginning Spanish

(Beginning Spanish is a prerequisite for any further Spanish courses)

Major topics include greetings, colors, numbers, the calendar, telling time, basic questions, likes and dislikes, pastimes, personality descriptions, expressing age and name. Students will also begin the exploration of the countries where Spanish is spoken.

Intermediate Spanish

Prerequisite: Beginning Spanish

This course continues the study of the Spanish language and culture. Major topics include school, classes, school schedules and supplies, health, leisure activities, feelings, and the community. **Intermediate Spanish, along with Beginning Spanish, is a prerequisite for Advanced Spanish.**

Advanced Spanish

Prerequisites: Beginning and Intermediate Spanish

This course continues the study of the Spanish language and culture. Major topics include the family, activities and celebrations, physical descriptions, restaurant and food vocabulary, housing and living quarters, and culture.

Students are required to successfully complete all three levels of Spanish (Beginning, Intermediate, and Advanced) AND take the Wake County Public Schools Spanish Exit Exam in order to receive high school credit.
