

ABOUT THE FVHS PSAT/NMSQT ADMINISTRATION

The PSAT will take place on October 2nd, during 1-3 periods. Students will be responsible for any missed work in their classes. This test will be online so the school issued chromebook is needed.

WHO SHOULD TAKE THE PSAT/NMSQT?

The PSAT/NMSQT is an **optional** test. Any interested FVHS student may take the PSAT/NMSQT. However, the PSAT/NMSQT contains items with Algebra and some Geometry concepts. Students often perform best when they have been successful in rigorous Math and English coursework. **Completion of Math I is strongly encouraged.**

While all high school students can register to take the PSAT/NMSQT, the district will only pay for **11th grade students** who are likely to qualify for the National Merit Scholarship. **The district will pay for the administration of current WCPSS 11th grade students who have a GPA in the top 10% of the district (4.375 or higher).** Any other students interested in taking the PSAT/NMSQT will be charged \$15.30 . Eleventh grade students with a GPA below the cutoff who want to participate will be charged the fee. Payment info will be sent out AFTER you register and will be due by Sep 25th.
