Grades 3-5 EOG Assessment Dates: Soon students in grades 3,4 and 5 will take the North Carolina End-Of-Grade Test for English Language Arts/Reading and Mathematics. Fifth grade students will also take the EOG test for Science. These assessments are designed to help measure students' yearlong progress on objectives within the three subject areas mentioned above. Listed below is our current testing schedule for Grades 3-5.

Friday, May 27 - Gr. 5 Science
Tuesday, May 30- Gr. 3-5 Reading
Wednesday, June 1- Gr. 3-5 Math
Thursday June 2- EOG makeups
Friday, June 3- Read to Achieve Testing

It is very important for students to be at school during this assessment window.

Please avoid absences or scheduling other appointments during these times, and make sure that your child arrives at school before 9:15 a.m. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to call or email your child's teacher.
