

## Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

Happy New Year! I hope you and your family had a wonderful and safe holiday. Please continue to stay safe so we have a COVID free start on January 20<sup>th</sup> when students return to the building. The teachers have shared that students were engaged on Monday and "hadn't missed a beat" in getting back to learning. Please do all you can to ensure your child is attending the "live instruction" which includes listening, engaging with the teacher, responding to questions, and having their camera on so teachers can actually see them. Also encourage your child to complete the classwork assigned. If you have any questions or concerns about how your child is doing, please reach out to your child's teacher. They are so willing to help!

As we are preparing for 58 more students coming into the building starting on January 20<sup>th</sup>, we are busy moving desks in our 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms to accommodate the 29-30 students per class. We will not be able to keep social distancing of students in these grade levels due to numbers of students returning to the building. Students MUST wear their masks correctly all day while in the classroom! We are moving Lunch and Recess schedules around to allow for the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders to now eat in the Cafeteria where they will be 6 feet a part facing the same direction when masks are off. This does mean that some grade levels will now be eating in their classrooms or outside on nice days (safely). Specials will stay at the same time but will follow a 6-day rotation so no group of students miss the same special on the Remote/Asynchronous Days. We have had to assign students to different teachers but those have occurred mostly for the students who have changed from VA to Plan A or Plan A to VA, as well as some who are moving to create homeroom classes for teachers moving from VA to Plan A to keep homerooms balanced and with the lowest numbers possible. Communication will go out on Thursday, January 14<sup>th</sup> to all families who have students who have been assigned a different teacher for second semester.

We also welcome new staff members to our Lacy team: Katherine Brook (long-term sub for Mrs. Buey), Monica Vance (1<sup>st</sup> grade teacher), Ryan Matthews (2<sup>nd</sup> grade teacher), Georgette Abdalla (2<sup>nd</sup> grade IA), and Elizabeth Eaddy (1<sup>st</sup> grade IA).

We have some exciting PTA and Foundation sponsored events coming up, so please make sure you have signed up for Memberhub to receive the weekly communication. STEMNight is next Tuesday with activities planned for everyone starting today (information is below)!

I look forward to what we can all do TOGETHER in 2021 as a Lacy Family – Together we are stronger! Continue to give yourself, your child, and the staff grace as we continue to navigate these unchartered waters around this pandemic.

The replacement will be checked out to the student and sent to the school. The school will contact you to swap the broken device for the replacement. This could take up to two weeks.
