#### How to Report a Broken WCPSS Device

- Visit StudentTechHelp.wcpss.net
- 2. **Complete** the online form.
- 3. You will be contacted by the WCPSS technology department to troubleshoot and **help to resolve** the issue.
- 4. If the issue **cannot be resolved**, a replacement will be ordered.

- 5. The replacement will be checked out to the student and **sent to the school.**
- 6. The **school will contact you** to swap the broken device for the replacement. This could take up to two weeks.

For families who would like to sign up for Virtual Academy for the spring or would like to change from Virtual Academy to Plan B, the registration process will occur **December 2**<sup>nd</sup>-**9**<sup>th</sup>.
