- 6. If you have a Broken WCPSS Device: Visit <u>StudentTechHelp.wcpss.net</u>. <u>Complete</u> the online form. You will be contacted by the WCPSS technology department to troubleshoot and <u>help to resolve</u> the issue. If the issue <u>cannot be resolved</u>, a replacement will be ordered. The replacement will be checked out to the student and <u>sent to the school</u>. The <u>school will contact you</u> to swap the broken device for the replacement. This could take up to two weeks.

7. Lacy Media Center Schedule - 2020-21

The Media Center book check-out schedule for the remainder of the school year is below. Students have a deadline for placing holds online and a scheduled book pick-up date. Students can keep the books for about three weeks. We are staggering book check-out and returns to better control the demand at any given time.
