Virtual Academy Next Year

Later today families will receive further messaging around Virtual Academy for next year. It is my hope that all students feel comfortable coming to school face to face, as that is the best learning environment. But, I know that Virtual Academy will be the best choice for same families based on circumstances.

Report Cards

Students will receive report cards today, Friday April 9. If your child is making level 1 and level 2 in reading and math, it is important that you have a conference with your child's teacher. Level 1 and level 2 grades mean that your child is not prepared to move on to the next grade level.

Materials

Students are in posession of many materials this school year. Please help us by returning all materials at the end of the year, with the exception of Chromebooks. At the end of the year, we will collect EL books, math manipulative kits, and other instructional materials that were sent home to families. Students who will continue in WCPSS next year will keep their Chromebooks. Students leaving for private, charter, or out of disctrict schools should return their Chromebooks.

Summer School

The state legislature has passed legislation to create a summer program for students to address the learning gaps caused by the pandemic. WCPSS is still finalizing what summer school will look like and where it will be offered. Stay tuned for more information regarding summer school in the coming weeks.
