This is Principal Newkirk with the update for the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year.

### **Welcome**

Welcome to another fabulous school year. We are only three weeks from the start of the 2022-2023 school year. We know these past few years have been a challenge, which makes it so important for your scholars to get back into the classroom engaged in learning.

### **Meet and Greet**

Students will find out who their teacher is during the week of August 22 via phone call from the teacher. We will have a brief Meet and Greet on Friday 26 for those who want to meet their child's teacher. Students in grades 1 and 2 will have Meet and Greet from 9:00 AM-11:00 AM. Students in grades 3-5 will have Meet and Greet from 1:00 PM – 3:00 PM. Meet and Greet for our kindergarten students will occur after staggered entry.

Aside from meeting the teacher, you may purchase meals from the cafeteria, join the PTA, return library books, speak with representatives from transportation and more.

### **Carpool Tags**

We will begin handing out carpool tags at the Meet and Greet on August 22. Families will receive one carpool tag. If your child will ride the bus most days, it is not necessary to get a carpool tag. You may pick up your carpool tags in the main office beginning August 22.

### **PTA**

My goal for this school year is for at least 80% of families to join the PTA. Membership is less than \$10 for the year, but the message it sends to teachers who see that their school community supports them is priceless. All parents are invited to join and are encouraged to join PTA.

It is through the fundraising of the PTA that we were able to place Smartboards in every classroom. PTA was instrumental in raising funds for the new solar panel installed in front of the school, and PTA will continue to raise funds to improve the student experience at Zebulon Elementary School.

## **Dress Code**

Students should wear clothes appropriate for learning. In that regard, students should not wear hoodies with the hoodie pulled over their head. Additionally, students should wear closed toes shoes to school daily. Sandals and flip flops are not appropriate.

## **Student Materials**

## **Bus Riders**

If your child will ride the bus to school this year, please put them on the bus beginning with the first day of school. Please continue to request transportation services if needed. Requests received after the cut-off date will be processed in the order that they are received.
