

Action needed today: Access WCPSS Senior Portal and Update Your Information

High School Seniors and Parents,

This email contains important, time-sensitive instructions for WCPSS Seniors. Please read it carefully.

The portal for seniors to access the information on their slide for the virtual graduation is now open as of 3 p.m. on Wednesday, May 20! You can use your WCPSS student email address and password to login.

If your information and photo are current, check the box to confirm that everything is correct.

If you need to correct your information,

- Check the box indicating that you need to make a correction to your information.
- Provide comments to indicate what corrections you need to make.
- Administration at your school will review and approve corrections as appropriate.

If you want to upload a photo ...

- The photo must be a senior portrait or a photo of the student in their cap and gown (Note: The portrait does not need to be a professional portrait. It can be one that you've taken at home.)
- Click on the upload button under the school provided yearbook photo.
- Choose a photo to upload, meeting the requirements below:
 - The file must be a .jpg
 - The student must be the only person in the photo and it must be appropriate for a formal graduation program.
 - [The photo must be taken in a vertical orientation \(portrait\)](#)
 - The photo must be a minimum of 720 pixel resolution on the longest edge.

The Student Portal will be closing at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, May 22. Please verify your information at the soonest possible time. If the data and photos are not reviewed and updated by the student, the school provided information will be used in the final graduation ceremony video.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. What if I don't have a WCPSS student email?

If you don't have a WCPSS student email, your school may have provided a personal email for login to the portal. You should receive an email at this address indicating you can use it for login.
