# **School Starts Monday**

## **Device Distribution**

All students who have requested a device will receive an email from WCPSS letting them know when the device is ready. Devices will be picked up at one of five distribution centers. # **Lunch Pickups**

Beginning August 31 students will either need to be with the parent picking up lunches or they will need the child's lunch number. Lunches will be offered at no cost until August 31 and then students will need to pay the normal rate.
