## Navigating Technology in a Virtual Environment

WCPSS has compiled a list of resources for students and families to reference to support technology use in this virtual environment. <u>Here</u> you can view how to log on to the Wake ID, access email, and many other tasks.

This year all teachers will use Google Classroom to house all instructional materials in the virtual environment. Students will find their assignments in Google classroom and they will turn in assignments in Google. Our Kindergarten and first grade teachers may use See-Saw embedded in a Google classroom. The first two weeks of school will be used as an orientation to help students become familiar with the expectations of each classroom in the virtual environment.

### Grade Level Item Pickups

Beginning on August 20 families are asked to stop by the school during assigned grade level times to pick up instructional materials to support at home learning. Families will drive through carpool to pick up items. More information is coming with more details. Pre-K will not have a pickup unless they do not begin in person on September 8. The schedule is as follows:

August 20 - 10:00 - 12:00 K and  $1^{st}$  grade item pickup August 21 - 10:00 - 12:00  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  grade item pick-up August 24 - 10:00 - 12:00  $4^{th}$  and  $5^{th}$  grade item pickup

### Virtual Meet the Teacher/Grade Level

Due to the changes created by Covid-19 and the structures it has created within schools with Virtual Academy, three cohorts, and remote learning, most students will receive instruction from all or most teachers on a grade level. All students will be assigned to a homeroom, but instruction may come from a different teacher. Teachers will begin calling families next week to tell you more about instruction for the upcoming school year. Each grade level as well as specialists are holding virtual Meet and Greets.

# Return to Campus Guide
