## **COVID-19 SAFETY PRACTICES UPDATE**

To maintain safe learning environments, WCPSS continues to make updates to safety practices for students and staff.

- For everyone over the age of 4, face coverings are required indoors in schools, on school-provided transportation, including school buses, activity buses, and vendor transportation. For Pre-K students, face coverings are strongly recommended for ages 3-4 and required for age 5. Face coverings remain optional outdoors.
- If your student experiences an illness that <u>does not include COVID-19 symptoms</u>, it's
  now easier for them to return to school quicker. For these illnesses, we're returning
  to pre-pandemic health practices: Students can return to school when they are
  fever-free without the use of fever-reducing medication for 24 hours. <u>Learn more</u>
  about returning to school after an illness.
- Safety practices for eating on campus have been strengthened. The goal is to keep students in school and to minimize the number of students who must quarantine due to (unmasked) exposure. Sanford Creek continues to utilize assigned seating during meals. Students are sitting beside the same peers as in their classroom. The practice of grouping students will help reduce the number of students required to quarantine if a student in their class becomes infected. Face coverings are required except for the time when students are specifically eating. We continue to practice safe socializing while in the cafeteria. Students are sitting less than 3ft apart without others directly across from them thus, facing the same direction. Students are all facing one of the 3 (out of 4) walls. Our practice does not include silent lunch. In an effort to minimize the amount of time students are unmasked (no more than 15 minutes), students are encouraged to eat first and then replace their mask to enjoy safely socializing.
- Homerooms have rotations of areas/zones at recess. Students from other homerooms on the grade level do not mix.

During the school day, if a student complains of not feeling well and is experiencing any of the symptoms below, a parent will be called to immediately pick him/her up.

- Fever or chills
- New cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatique
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache

- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- · Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

### It is critical for sick students to stay home under the following circumstances:

- They are feeling sick or experiencing any symptom of illness, unless the individual has a confirmed diagnosis from a healthcare professional attributing the symptoms to something other than COVID-19.
- They have been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 10 days.
- They have been in close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 2 weeks and have not met the requirements to return to school.

# TRANSPORTATION UPDATES

BUS: With the reopening of traditional schools for the 2021-22 school year, there will be more buses and traffic on the road in the morning and afternoon beginning 8/23/21. This change may impact the AM and PM arrival times of year-round school buses to their stops over the next two weeks. Please be patient as routes settle and drivers and students become familiar with recent changes. Since estimated stop times may vary until routes settle, students should be ready and waiting for their bus at the bus stop least 10 minutes before it is expected to arrive in the AM.
