COVID-19: MASKING UPDATE

Monday, March 7th, **masks** are **recommended, but not required (a.k.a.: OPTIONAL)** in schools, on school buses and vendor transportation for all students, staff, and visitors.

New <u>health guidance</u> has been approved by the WCPSS School Board which allows students, staff, and visitors to go "mask-optional" beginning Monday, March 7. Each family should have a conversation to determine your family's expectations for mask-wearing at school. Please note that SCE staff will not be in a position to remind or coach students on whether or not they should wear their masks. Mask-optional is truly *mask-optional*. Each individual member (students, staff, and visitors) of the school community will decide what is best for them and that will be honored.

COVID-19: CONTACT TRACING ELIMINATED

As a part of the recent updates to the *StrongSchools* NC Toolkit, it is no longer necessary to conduct individual contact tracing for possible exposures. **Only COVID-positive cases will be reported**. According to the Toolkit, the change is made because "individual contact tracing is a less effective tool for responding to the pandemic at this phase."

When deciding if your child is a good candidate for SSA, consider:

- Your child's social and emotional maturity.
- Your child may be taking classes with peers who may be older.
- Your child's organizational skills and ability to focus.
- Can your child begin or complete projects by themselves?
- Your child will be skipping an entire year's worth of content and background knowledge.
