## Good Afternoon Sanford Creek Families!

I hope that you and your family are enjoying the cool, fall-like weather and of course, track-out! There are many items for focus in the coming weeks, so let's jump to it.

WCPSS announced that it will begin allowing small groups of students in Preschool, Regional Special Education Programs, and Grades K-3 to return to school on **October 26**. Read more details at this link.

At this time, the learning environment (*Plan B or Virtual Academy*) your family selected will be the environment you will need to follow, at least through the first semester. The School Board has indicated that all families will have an opportunity to select which option (Virtual Academy or Plan B/in-person learning) that they desire for the second semester by late October/early November.

We are excited about welcoming students back to Sanford Creek! Plan B families have been assigned to a cohort (1,2, or 3). The cohort assignment indicates the week for your child(ren) to be on campus for in-person/face-to-face orientation and instruction. During reopening there will be changes that all families and students will be expected to follow for the health and safety of students and staff.

- Students will be required to wear masks.
- Visitors and volunteers will not be allowed into the building at this time.
- Temperature checks will occur before students enter the building.
- Families will be contacted and asked to pick up their child if they present symptoms during the school day.
- Students will need to bring their own water bottles to school.
- Additionally, students will be expected to bring their WCPSS issued device fully charged, along with their charging cord, with them to school each day.

Over the next two weeks, you will receive much more grade level specific information about your child's return to Sanford Creek ES. More information about what the return to learning will look like for WCPSS students can be found at this link: https://www.wcpss.net/Page/33111.

One of the most common questions I am receiving involves scheduling for when students return. Administration and teacher leaders are working to create a schedule that provides an equitable learning experience for students in-person and for those learning from home. We are working to ensure that each student still connects with his/her homeroom teacher daily. There may be instances where grade level teams will share the instructional load to address all learners more effectively in all settings. This work is complex and tricky. We appreciate your patience as we work out these details

for you in the coming weeks. We will continue to update you with Sanford Creek specific information as things evolve.
