We have received funding to operate a 21st Century Community Learning Center (CCLC) after school program at our school. Students participating in the program named it "Incredible Dreamer Club". We are excited about partnering with the Poe Center, other Wake County high schools and you to make sure every student has the opportunity to succeed academically and in life.





WHAT IS ENLOE AFTER HOURS?

Enloe After Hours is a 28 week after school program held during the academic school year. Our students have named our program "Incredible Dreamers Club". During each session, students are provided structured time to work on homework assignments and projects. Staff will work with students, and communicate with their classroom teachers to plan for student success. Additionally, the program offers life skills; enrichment activities that introduces students to health-related careers; and other enrichment activities and engagement experiences for the entire family.
