This Year's theme is "I will Change the world by..." All entries should relate to how you interpret the theme. Students submit their completed works of art in one or all of the available arts categories: **Dance Choreography, Film Production, Literature, Music Composition, Photography, Visual Arts.**

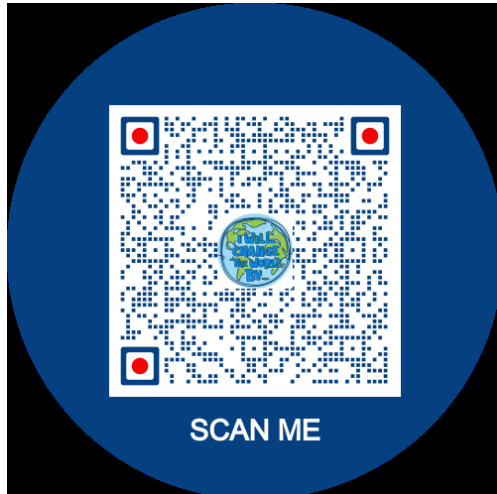
Reflections competition is virtual this year, which means you will need to send your pieces electronically via the attached online form. **You should receive confirmation of your entry within 4 hours of sending it. If not, please reach out to dillardrivemiddlereflections@gmail.com**

Visual art projects must include one photo, but multiple angles are helpful for judges as well. For film & dance, multiple students may participate, but only one may be listed as the entrant. That should be the person who choreographed the dance or directed the film.

Each entry must contain a title and all entries must include an artist statement. *The artist statement communicates what inspired the work, how it relates to the theme, and the content of the work. The statement must include at least 10 words and not exceed 100 words. The artist statement is worth 40 out of 100 points and is just as important as the artwork.*

Only new pieces of artwork inspired by the current year's theme may be submitted.
