### 2021-2022 Testing Support or Points of Emphasis CogAT/Iowa Assessments (Grades 5-8) and Deadlines

#### Testing Windows for Fall

Testing Windows:

- Aug. 23- Sept. 8 Track 1
- Sept. 13- Sept. 22 **Modified and Leadership Academies**
- Sept. 20-Sept. 29 Track 2, 3, 4
- Oct. 18- Oct. 29 Traditional and Governor's School

**Fall testing documents are turned into the Testing Office 8:00-4:00 using the following schedule:**

Turn in Windows:

- Sept. 9-10 Track 1
- Sept. 30- Oct. 1 Track 2, 3, 4
- Sept. 23 Modified and Leadership Academies
- Nov. 1-2 Traditional and Governor's School

**Fall 4-8 ISPs must be submitted by December 18, 2021 for traditional calendar schools. Year Round (Tracks 2-4) and modified calendars are due Dec. 22 and Track 1 is due Dec. 4, 2021.**

#### Testing Windows for Spring

Testing Windows:

- Jan. 6- Jan. 19 Traditional, Modified, Leadership Academies, Tracks 1, 2, 3
- Jan. 31- Feb. 11 Track 4 and Governor's School

**Third Grade ISPs (all calendar schedules) need to be finalized during February so that third grade identification will not run into the Spring identification process.**

**All Spring 4-8 testing documents are turned into the Testing Office 8:00-4:00 using the following schedule:**

Turn in Windows:

- Jan. 20-21 Traditional, Modified, Leadership Academies, Tracks 1, 2, 3
- Feb. 14-15 Track 4 and Governor's School

**Spring 3-8 ISPs must be submitted by April 8, 2021 for traditional and modified calendars. For Year Round calendars Tracks 1-3 are due Apr. 15 and Track 4 is due March 25.**

**If a student has an Incomplete CogAT, you must request RIAS 2. DO NOT Administer RIST 2.**

**Testing Office requests the following:**

- AIG Teacher/ Test Administrators are responsible for returning all 1<sup>st</sup> semester and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester CogAT and Iowa answer documents to be scored to the Testing Office at 1551 Rock Quarry Road. • Testing Office hours are 8:00 AM-5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Answer documents must be turned in by 4:00 p.m.
- **ALL test answer documents are due to the Testing Office on the day scheduled (above).** • Test documents must be returned on the scheduled turn in dates to the Testing Office and **cannot be turned in after the required date for submission.**
- Use of the WCPSS courier service for the return of completed answer documents is not permitted.

## Scheduling the Tests

The CogAT should be administered in three separate sessions for third grade students on three separate days as noted on page 9, *Directions for Administration* booklet. 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade AIG testing can shorten the administration sessions.

The Iowa should be administered in two separate sessions on two separate days for third grade students as noted on page 6, *Directions for Administration* booklet. 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade AIG testing can shorten the administration sessions.

**You must meet testing turn in dates.**

## Test Materials

Use the *Testing Materials Request Form* tab under Identification Links on the AIG Headquarters Canvas course to request additional testing materials, answer sheets and/or replacement test books.

Questions regarding additional materials should be directed to the AIG Department.

**Check answer documents closely. All information must match what is listed in PowerSchool.** If the answer document has incorrect data, including mistakes such as wrong DOB, grade, test level, student identification number, or proper name, then the test will have to be re-scored by the publisher and may delay test score dissemination.
