Welcome to our kindergarten students today! We've had an amazing opening to school this year! Thank you, parents, for your support and efforts to help us get off to a strong start. Please read below for important beginning-of-year reminders

Arrival & Dismissal:

Our top priority is the safety and wellbeing of our students. Thank you in advance for complying with our rules and procedures.

The front door opens at 8:00am. As a safety precaution, children should not be left alone to wait until school is open. Students dropped off prior to 8:00am should enroll in our Before School program. Applications can be picked up in the main office and the gym.

We encourage independence with our students. Please drop them off in carpool. During the first two weeks of staggered entry, kindergarten parents can walk students to class. Beginning Tuesday, 9/3/19. We ask all other grade levels to use carpool or walk their child to the front door only. If you need to talk with your child teacher, please send a note or email requesting a conference time.

Students are NEVER to be dropped off in the front parking lot or at the safety barrier. It is unsafe and we have had instances where students were almost hit running between cars. We request that you remain in the carpool lane.

From WAKE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS:

Meal prices increase for 2019-20

At elementary schools, full-paid lunches will increase 20 cents to \$2.75. At middle and high schools, full paid lunches will increase 20 cents to \$3.00. Breakfast prices remain the same as last year. Full paid breakfast will remain \$1.25 at elementary schools and \$1.50 at middle and high schools. The meal prices remain reasonable compared to other school systems in North Carolina.

Federal law - the Paid Lunch Equity requirement of the Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act - requires school lunch price increases until Paid Lunch Equity is established. The most recent weighted average lunch price gap based on 2016-17 meal prices was \$0.38 based on calculations using the WCPSS 2019-20 PLE Tool. Lunch prices are being increased to reduce the price gap.

School lunch continues to be a great value. Meals are nutrient rich and include low-fat dairy, whole grains, lean meats, and an assortment of fruits and vegetables with a variety of offerings for students to choose from daily.
