These characteristics have been at the forefront of the organization since its inception in 1921. In addition to recognizing students for their past accomplishments, the organization encourages students to become active members in their community through service and leadership.

- First-semester Junior or Senior Year
- Cumulative unweighted academic GPA of 3.50 or higher
- Minimum 30 service hours per semester
- No incidence of academic dishonesty
- Complete the National Honor Society Application or Renewal Form by the deadline

Once students are accepted into the Knightdale High School chapter of the National Honor Society students are expected to:

• Scholarship

Per national guidelines, at a minimum, students must have a cumulative GPA 3.50 or higher

• Service

This involves voluntary contributions made by a student to the school or community, done without compensation.

Leadership

Student leaders are those who are resourceful, good problem solvers, and idea contributors. Leadership experiences can be drawn from school or community activities while working with or for others.

Character

The student of good character is cooperative; demonstrates high standards of honesty and reliability; shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others; and generally, maintains a clean disciplinary record.

- Attendance at monthly meetings
- Participation in an annual service project
