- 3. Permission form signed by a parent in the presence of a CHS staff member. Parent must present a photo ID.

CHS Off-Campus Rules

- 1. Payment can be paid via the Cary High website: wcpss.net/caryhs → Parents → Online Payments
- 2. Students who owe school fees of any kind will not be permitted to purchase a lunch pass until all fees have been paid.
- 3. The school assumes no liability for any accident or injury incurred in the exercise of this lunch pass.
- 4. No temporary passes will be issued for misplaced or forgotten lunch passes.
- 5. The lunch pass allows the student to leave campus during his/her regularly scheduled lunch period, provided he/she has their lunch pass <u>in his/her possession at the time</u>. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary consequences for skipping. A photo on your phone is not acceptable.
- 6. Students with a class average below 60% (D) in any class may result in having their off-campus lunch privileges suspended until they improve their academic standing.
- 7. The student and parent are responsible for where the student goes for lunch and for his/her transportation
- 8. Students exercising off-campus lunch privileges are subject to the rules of student conduct as applicable to the regular school day adopted by the Wake County School Board and Cary High School.
- 9. Any student who is referred to the administration for disciplinary action may have his/her lunch pass revoked or suspended by school administration.
- 10. Any student who provides transportation off campus for a student who does not have a lunch pass will lose his/her lunch and parking privileges. Offense 1 = 10 days, Offense 2 = Quarter, Offense 3= Semester
- 11. Being tardy from off campus lunch carries the same consequences as the over-all school policy regarding tardiness.

In the rare circumstance that a student cannot return to school after lunch, a parent or legal guardian must contact the Attendance Office at 919-460-3549, ext 21805 to avoid disciplinary action for skipping.
