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Guest Form Information

ALL GUEST FORMS DUE: JANUARY 30 LATE FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!

Guest Forms available on the website

Notification if not approved by: February 3rd OR 5 days from submission.

Before you turn in your form:

- 1.Read the guest form fully!
- 2. Make sure application is completely filled out including signatures.
- 3. Make sure to have a clear printed ID (school, license, passport) of the guest.
- 4. No faxed documents will be accepted.

Where to turn it in?

When you have your completed application and guest ID you will bring it to the Front Office and place it in the box with Mrs. Hardesty. If your guest lives OUT OF TOWN it may be emailed to Ms. Hardesty at jbondhardesty@wcpss.net.

How will you know if your Guest Form is approved?

Students will be notified through their school email by MONDAY, February 3RD or 5 days from submission if their guest is NOT approved, If you would like to check status wait 5 days and then you may email Ms. Graves or Mrs. Hardesty. The sooner you get your paperwork in the sooner you will receive approval. Approval is based on a committe of faculty.
