School Facts

Millbrook High School, grades 9-12, is a public secondary school, offering the International Baccalaureate Middle Years and Diploma Programmes. The total enrollment is 2,376 students. Located in the northern suburbs of the state capital of North Carolina, Millbrook is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. There are 183 members of the faculty with a support staff of 10 secretaries and guidance technicians.

AP, IB, and honors courses are offered in the areas of English, mathematics, science, social studies, foreign language, career and technical education, healthful living and the arts. Millbrook works with local uni-

versities and community colleges to provide dual enrollment opportunities for selected courses. The CTE Department offers course work in the following areas: agriculture, business, health sciences, marketing and family and consumer sciences. We also have a Digital Media Academy. Special programs are available for exceptional students who meet state guidelines.

Millbrook is a 4A high school governed by the NC High School Athletic Association. The Wildcats compete in football, basketball, baseball, softball, soccer, track, cross country, golf, swimming, volleyball, wrestling, lacrosse, tennis and gymnastics and are recognized statewide for athletic excellence.
