Schedule Pick-up & Change Days

In order to protect instructional time, all East Wake High students will have the opportunity to pick up schedules, parking passes, off-campus lunch passes, and locker assignments and to make schedule changes before the first day of school. These tasks must be done on Monday, August 10 or Tuesday, August 11 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4 p.m. There will be stations set up for each area in the cafeteria. Freshman students will get their schedules at Freshman Orientation.

Extensive time was spent developing a master schedule that provides the best educational opportunities for our students. Schedule changes have serious effects on staffing, class sizes and academic programs and will be made with administration approval on August 10 and August 11 only. Administrators and counselors will be available on Thursday, August 20 from 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. to address emergency schedule issues only! No schedules will be changed on or after August 24. If a course is dropped after the 10th day of the semester, the course will appear on the transcript as WF (Withdraw Failing).

The following reasons are NOT considered appropriate reasons for schedule changes and will not be honored:

- Dropping or adding a course because you changed your mind.
- Block (class period) preference.
- Teacher preference.

Parking Passes

All student drivers may submit parking applications beginning August 1. Students may submit payments online or mail money orders with the completed application.

- Students must show a valid NC driver's license to purchase and pick up the tag.
- All fines and fees must be cleared before the tag is issued.
- Parking tags will not be sold during the first week of school.
- Students must present a copy of their valid driver's license with their application.
- Students who park on campus without a valid WCPSS parking tag will be booted or towed at the owner's expense.
- Applications can be downloaded from the East Wake High School website or picked up in the office.

Online payment of \$170.00 is preferred. Other forms of payment must be cash, money order, certified check or cashier's check. Personal checks will not be accepted. Cash payments must be made in person.

Fees & Fines

All fines, debts and other financial obligations must be cleared before students can purchase parking passes and off-campus lunch passes. Please contact our bookkeeper, Roxann Ferguson at 919-365-2625.



Cafeteria Guidelines

While eating breakfast or lunch, students must stay in the cafeteria and remain seated. **No food should be in any academic areas**. Restaurants are not allowed to deliver food to the school.

Before School

When students arrive on campus, they must report to the cafeteria, media center or school courtyard (main gym on rainy days – seated in bleachers).

Late Arrival, Early Dismissal & Tardy Policy

Students who arrive to school after 7:35 a.m. must report directly to the Attendance office located down the hall from the Main office to receive a pass to class. All students will check out from the attendance office. Staff will sweep students into class each period daily. All student tardies will be documented for the frequency and school consequences will be issued after the third tardy. Students begin each quarter with zero tardies. Parents can contact the Attendance office at 919-365-2649.

Operation BAG IT & TAG IT



During the academic day (7:20 AM – 2:18 PM) cell phones or other electronics should not be used, seen or heard while in an academic setting such as classrooms, field trips, instruction outside, etc.. Students are permitted to use electronics to listen to music during lunch **only**. If at any time a student needs to make a call during the school day they must use the designated school phone. At no time should phones

be used in classrooms or office areas. If the policy is violated, students are expected to give the item to the adult. The items will be held in the main office where a parent can pick them up at the end of the next school day. Items will only be returned to a parent. If the student refuses to give the item to the staff member, the student will be brought to the office and may receive ISS. If the student refuses to give the item to an administrator, the student will receive three days of OSS. In addition to electronic items, we will also confiscate head gear and any other items that violate WCPSS or EWHS policies. ALL VISIBLE ITEMS WILL BE CONFISCATED ON THE FIRST DAY!!!

Dress Code Policy

We are committed to providing a safe and orderly learning environment for all students. For this reason, we will enforce a strict dress code. As you plan your wardrobe, please review the WCPSS Inappropriate Dress Policy (6410.1) and plan accordingly.

The following are prohibited: exposed undergarments, sagging pants, excessively short or tight garments (must be as long as the bottom of your finger tips), bare midriff shirts, strapless shirts, shirts with spaghetti straps and tank tops, attire with messages or illustrations that are lewd, indecent or vulgar or that advertise any product or service not permitted by law to minors, head covering of any kind, see-through clothing, any adornment such as chains or spikes that could reasonably be perceived as or used as a weapon, any symbols, styles or attire frequently associated with intimidation, violence or violent groups about which students at a particular school have been notified, and sunglasses should not be worn inside the building unless there is a medical condition that requires protective eyewear. We reserve the right to specify additional items of dress or appearance that may be disruptive to the school environment. Students who are not able to correct the violation immediately will remain in ISS until the problem is corrected.

Lockers

Each student should review his/her class schedule and choose a locker location that will minimize travel time between classes. Locker assignments will be for the entire school year. Lockers and combination locks can be obtained on the designated pick-up dates. Students who fail to check out lockers and locks before the first day of school will have to check them out before school, during lunch or after school in the front office.

Parent/Student Handbooks

At East Wake High School, we believe that parents, students, and staff must work together to provide a quality educational experience. Each student will be given a copy of the 2015-2016 East Wake High School Parent/Student Handbook. These documents are designed to provide support and assistance. We encourage parents and students to review all information contained in these documents.

Off Campus Lunch

WCPSS Board Policy 6130 allows principals to determine off-campus lunch provisions for eligible juniors and seniors. It is important that parents and students understand the expectations and rules governing off-campus lunch privileges for East Wake High School. Juniors and seniors should review the guidelines that are located on the application with their parents before completing the application. A few reminders are listed below:

- Lunch pass identification cards will be distributed on August 10 and 11 during pick up times. Lunch passes will cost \$10 each. The make-up date is August 20 during Meet the Teacher/Open House hours.
- Students who do not get passes during these times must wait until August 26. Passes will not be issued on the first day of school.
- Students may not leave campus for lunch on the same day their lunch pass is processed. Lunch passes will only be issued on Wednesdays.
- Students must clear all fines and fees before they can purchase the off-campus lunch pass.
- Parents who wish to avoid standing in line for this process may have their signature **notarized**. Otherwise, parents must come to East Wake High School and sign the application in the presence of school personnel.
- Students and parents are responsible for securing transportation. Only students with a valid parking tag will be allowed to park on campus. Towing will be enforced.
- Off campus lunch is a privilege which may be revoked for disciplinary infractions.
- Applications can be downloaded from the East Wake High School website or picked up in the office.
